

Old Testament Lesson

Isaiah 49:1-7

Listen to me, O coastlands; pay attention, you peoples from far away! The LORD called me before I was born; while I was in my mother's womb he named me.

He made my mouth like a sharp sword; in the shadow of his hand he hid me; he made me a polished arrow; in his quiver he hid me away.

And he said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will be glorified."

But I said, "I have labored in vain; I have spent my strength for nothing and vanity; yet surely my cause is with the LORD and my reward with my God."

And now the LORD says, who formed me in the womb to be his servant, to bring Jacob back to him, and that Israel might be gathered to him, for I am honored in the sight of the LORD, and my God has become my strength-

Chiming in

Don't you just love the bells! Our bell choir, called the Aldersgate Bell Choir, chimes on the 3rd Sunday of the month and for special times, such as Easter.

They practice on Wednesday evenings from 6:15 to 7:15 PM, during the school calendar. There are five octaves of

handbells, which means we have spots for up to 14 ringers, which is what we currently have. However, the director is always on the lookout for substitute ringers, particularly people with experience playing handbells or those who can play piano. (Handbell music generally looks like advanced piano music. Ringers need to be able to pick out the two to four notes (bells) that they are responsible for playing.)

If at least 5 people, preferably with past experience playing a musical instrument, would like to learn bells, a small beginner handbell choir could be formed.
